Expert on the subject at the chair of *architectural and urban design* (Prof. Giuseppe Strappa, “Sapienza” University of Rome), and Adjunct Professor at the School of Architecture, University of Miami. Since 2003 he is member of the association History of cities (founded by Prof. Enrico Guidoni), since 2007 of ISUF *International Seminar on Urban Form*, founding member of ISUF Italy, and since 2014 member of ICOMOS Italy. He is research director of the Association for Historical Dialogue and Research (AHDR), Cyprus. Editorial Board Member of the Journal of Social and Applied Sciences, Girne American University, and editor of *Forma Civitatis: International Journal of Urban and Territorial Morphological Studies* and member of the editorial board of *Phlogiston, Journal of the History of Science*, published by the Museum of Science and Technology, Belgrade. Has attended Post-Doctoral studies at the Department of Architecture of "Sapienza", University of Rome, holds a Ph.D. in History of Cities from "Sapienza", University of Rome and a Master of Science in Architecture from "Sapienza", University of Rome, Italy. Has published books and articles on “Urban morphology”, “Il tesoro delle città”, “Storia dell’urbanistica”. His main research interests are on medieval and modern urban history, architectural theories, and urban morphology. Has contributed to national and international researches on Ravenna, Rome, the Aniene Valley, and Cyprus.
